**ALOHA PETROLEUM TO CELEBRATE GRAND REOPENING OF  
ALOHA ISLAND MART AND FUELING STATION IN WAIANAЕ**

Honolulu, Hawaii (January 16, 2014) – Aloha Petroleum, Ltd. will celebrate the grand reopening of the Aloha Island Mart and fueling station in Waianae with three full days of festivities. From January 30 through February 1, customers will enjoy daily giveaways, in-store specials and sweepstakes prizes including up to \$300 in Aloha gift cards and a 40” flat screen TV.

“We’re extremely proud of our newly renovated Aloha Island Mart in Waianae,” said Richard Parry, president and CEO of Aloha Petroleum. “It demonstrates our commitment to meeting the needs of our Waianae coast customers by providing a newer, brighter, and easier to use store with expanded store offerings, particularly fresh, healthy food. It is good to invest in the Waianae community and also showcase our efforts to build more sustainable facilities throughout the Islands.”

Aloha Petroleum incorporated a number of green efficiencies in the redesign of the Waianae location, including the installation of 12 LED canopy light fixtures and 46 photovoltaic solar panels. Made of recyclable non-toxic material, the energy-efficient LED lights will reduce electricity consumption from 460 watts to 94 watts per light fixture and save on replacement costs due to the product’s longer lifespan. Additionally, the PV panels are expected to produce 25 percent of the electrical power consumption at the store.

“This is part of a larger initiative to show our aloha to the environment by moving toward more sustainable, energy-efficient green technologies that will translate to direct savings to the bottom line” said Parry.

To date, Aloha Petroleum has installed canopy LED lighting at 21 of its locations statewide. The company has also installed PV solar panels at five other locations, including Aloha Island Marts at Diamond Head, Kahala, King Street, Dillingham and Keauhou, resulting in a reduction of electrical consumption by between 20 and 45 percent, depending upon the store’s location.

The renovation of the Waianae location also included the installation of a new fuel canopy, upgraded fuel pumps and interior improvements that allow for more generous aisles and optimal food and beverage displays with an expanded selection of hot and cold snack items.
