**ALOHA ISLAND MART IN KAHALA TO RE-OPEN
AFTER EXTENSIVE 4-MONTH RENOVATION**

Honolulu, Hawai'i (June 10, 2011) – Aloha Petroleum's new flagship convenience store in Kahala opens this weekend after a four-month, \$2 million renovation.

The 3,000-square-foot convenience store, located on Waiialae Avenue across from Kahala Mall, was blessed Thursday morning by Kahu Kelekona Bishaw and Kahu Kaleo Patterson, and will open to the public on Saturday. The original, 670-square-foot convenience store was demolished in January.

The new store features a walk-in beer cave, a soda dispenser that offers more than 100 flavor combinations, an expanded selection of hot and cold snack items, and public restrooms. The fueling station also underwent a complete overhaul and now boasts a new fuel canopy and upgraded fuel dispensers.

Runners will be pleased to learn that the new store has not one, but two water fountains installed along the rear of the building.

A grand re-opening celebration, featuring prize giveaways and the chance to win \$1,000 worth of free gas, will be held in July.
